Paul Corless from Cheshire & Merseyside NHS Trust has introduced a Burtonwood Living Well Bus which will be parked at the local Community Centre, Green Jones Brow on Wednesday 17th December from 10.30am to 1pm and from 1.30pm to 4pm the Living Well Bus will be parked at the library.

You can go along during these times where they will be offering health checks, including cholesterol and glucose testing, as well as mental health signposting.

Burtonwood Community Centre is a "warm space," offering a heated lounge with TVs and refreshments like hot drinks and snacks. This initiative aims to provide a welcoming and comfortable place for people to gather, connect and stay warm. How do Food Pantries work?:

Step 1: Find your nearest pantry (you must live in the area in which it is based).

Step 2: Go along and join on the day it is open, remembering it is open to everyone in that community.

Step 3: Pay your £5 membership each time you visit. Sit and have a cuppa while you wait for your turn.

Step 4: Choose your shopping, which will always be worth more than your weekly membership fee.

Step 5: Tell your neighbours and get them to join too.
